Course Familiarization

Handlers in all classes are permitted to walk the course, *without a dog*, prior to the start of the class. A walk-through period will be held prior to each class, following the judge's briefing. The judges briefing will outline the course and answer handler questions. A warm up jump shall be available for all exhibitors. There will be NO OBSTACLE FAMILIARIZATION AT THIS TRIAL

Move Up Regulations

If a dog earns an agility title before this event, it can be advanced to the next level of competition. However, written notice MUST be given to Trial Secretary no later than the Monday BEFORE the trial. Move-ups will be accommodated from Saturday to Sunday. Move-ups will be added to the end of the running order of the class they move up to and every effort will be made to accommodate handlers running multiple dogs in the same class. No verbal changes will be accepted.

Refunds

No entry fees will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other causes beyond the control of the organizing committee. Entry fees shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by a veterinarian or judge, or barred from competition by action of the Trial Committee. Bitches in season will be awarded a refund with a Veterinary certificate, less \$10 processing fee per day.

Class Information Standard Classes

Novice Agility Class- The Novice Agility class is divided into Division A for persons and dogs never having acquired an agility title, and Division B for dogs that have acquired the Novice Agility title, persons that have handled a dog to an agility title, and for Agility judges.

Open Agility Class- Open to dogs that have acquired the Novice Agility or Open Agility titles but which have not acquired the Agility Excellent Title.

Agility Excellent Class "A" and "B":- Excellent A is open to dogs that have acquired the Open Agility title, and to dogs that have acquired the Agility Excellent Title. Excellent "B" is open to dogs that have acquired the Agility Excellent Title.

Class Information Jumpers With Weaves Classes

Novice JWW Class - Novice "A" open to persons/dogs that have not acquired an agility title. Novice "B" open to dogs that have acquired the Novice JWW title or persons who have handled a dog to an agility title, and for Agility Judges.

Open JWW Class - Open to dogs that have acquired the Novice JWW title or the Open JWW title but which have not acquired a qualifying score towards an Excellent JWW title.

Excellent JWW Class "A" and "B" - The excellent JWW class is divided into two divisions. Division "A" for dogs that have not acquired the Excellent JWW title and Division "B" for dogs that have achieved the Excellent JWW title.

MACH Title

Dogs earning perfect scores in the Excellent B classes will be able to count these scores/legs toward the MACH (Master Agility Championship) title. Dogs will receive 1 point for every full second they run under the Standard Course Time. A dog finishing in 1st place will be credited with double the number of points earned; a dog finishing in 2nd place will be credited with 1 ½ times the points earned (fractions rounded down). A total of 750 points is required to earn the MACH title. Additionally, a dog must earn perfect scores in both the Standard and JWW classes on the same day. 20 different days, as the second part of the MACH.

**Preferred Classes are offered at all levels per AKC rules.
Nov A, Nov B, Open, Exc A, Exc B - Standard and JWW classes**

All dogs **must** start in Novice Preferred regardless of title level already earned previously in the regular agility program. There is NO grandfathering of titles.

The owner may choose to enter the Preferred Std Agility Class and the Preferred JWW Class in lieu of entering the regular classes at any trial, HOWEVER, dog must be entered only in Preferred Classes **or** in Regular Classes, with no crossover between them being allowed at the same set of trials.

Owner/dogs are allowed to switch back and forth between the Preferred Classes and the Regular Classes, *but not at the same set of trials*

Preferred classes will run concurrent with each regular height division.

Preferred is scored identical to the regular classes except that 5 Seconds is added to the SCT after standard calculations for original level.

Height Division

Owners are responsible for entering the proper height divisions. Judges reserve the right to measure dogs entered in the trial. All dogs will be measured if a height card is not shown in advance or day of trial.

Dogs Eligible to Enter:

This trial is open to all dogs over the age of 12 months that are registered with the American Kennel Club, or have AKC Limited Registration, or are of a registerable breed that have obtained an AKC ILP number. Dogs eligible for entry in the Miscellaneous Class at dog shows are eligible to participate. Spayed bitches and neutered males are eligible to participate. Bitches in season, aggressive dogs, dogs that are blind or deaf or suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect its physical or mental performance, are not eligible to participate.

Collars

At the handler's option, the dog may wear a flat (buckle or quick release) collar without tags or other attachments. Choke collars, pinch collars, electric & dummy electric collars are prohibited. No food, toys, or other aids or devices of any kind are permitted in the ring.

Ringside

Dogs are not required to be at the trial until the scheduled time of judging. All dogs not needed for further judging are excused. The owner or handler of each dog is solely responsible for having it ready at ringside when the class is to be judged. Please help your fellow competitors, the trial workers, and the judge by checking in with the gate steward well ahead of your run, and being prompt at the line when your turn comes to run.

Liability

It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dog and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Trial committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such cases, no refund of any fees paid will be made WCWDCA. and its agents, employees, etc. will assume no responsibilities for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors or handlers, or to any of their dogs or property, & further assume no responsibility for injury to children.

Notice to exhibitors

- The safety of the dogs is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport and that their dogs are familiar with, and able to perform all the obstacles safely.
- Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dogs at show and at hotels. Any exhibitor failing to do so may be excused from the show by the trial committee with no refund.
- All dogs must be on lead except when in the ring or in the warm up area.
- Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. The secretary will add a fee of \$25 to any returned check.
- Food will be available on site .
