Notice To Exhibitors: A Recording Fee of 50 cents & a \$1.50 Event Fee will be required for each dog entered at any Licensed or Member Club Show, Obedience Trial or Tracking Test. This Recording Fee is to be collected by the Show-giving Club and paid to the American Kennel Club. If a dog is entered in more than one class in the show, the Recording Fee is to be collected on the first entry only. (American Kennel Club Rule, Chapter 11, Section 2)

Make all Check and Money Orders Payable "Weimaraner Club of the Washington DC Area" (WCWDCA). Returned or post dated checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. **Canadian** exhibitors must make fees payable in **US Funds**.

Telegraph, telephone and unsigned Entries Cannot be accepted. Entries Not On Official AKC Entry Forms and Photocopies of Entry Forms without Agreement and Rules on the reverse side of the Official AKC Entry Form are Not Acceptable.

Entry Fees Shall Not be Refunded if a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Veterinarian or Judge or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee. If because of riot, civil disturbance or other acts beyond the control of the management, it is impossible to open or complete the show, no refund of entry fee will be made. **No Refund** for Bitches in season in Obedience

Owners are Responsible For Errors in making out entry forms, whoever may make such errors, and no entry fee will be refunded in the event of such errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date.

Dogs May Arrive any time prior to their scheduled time of judging. Dogs not required for further judging will be excused.

Foreign Dogs are eligible for Puppy and Open Classes effective 1/1/85

Cash Prizes will be paid in the ring to the person showing the dog. The Club disclaims any liability for cash prizes after the judging is over.

All Trophies must be claimed the day of the show. None will be mailed.

Best of Breed Competition

Limited to dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs that according to their owners' records have completed the requirements for a championship but whose championships are unconfirmed.

Awards of Merit: The specialty Judge may at his/her discretion award Judge's Awards of Merit to a maximum of 10% of the Best of Breed entry, plus Winners Dog and Winners Bitch, along with the Winners of the Veteran, Field Trial and Versatile Classes.

Best Puppy: During the course of judging regular classes, the specialty judge will select a Best Puppy from the class winners of the six to nine month and nine to twelve month classes. This will be done after the Best of Breed judging unless the Best Puppy award is automatic. Example: An entry from the puppy classes is awarded Best of Winners of Best of Breed. Only dogs or bitches undefeated in a puppy class are eligible for Best Puppy Competition. If the first place winner is no present, the second place winner **may not compete. There is no additional entry fee for this competition.**

Non Regular Classes Involving Single Dog Entries

Veteran Dog: for dogs at least 7 years of age (same class for bitches). Spayed bitches and neutered dogs eligible for Veterans Class

Field Trial Dog: for dogs that have placed in an AKC Licensed or Member Field Trial or who have been awarded an AKC Hunting Test Title or who have been awarded a WCA Field or Water Rating prior to the closing date of this Show. (same class for bitches).

Versatile/Versatile Excellent: For dogs that have been awarded the title of Versatile or Versatile Excellent from the Weimaraner Club of America (same class for bitches)

Non Regular Classes Involving Multiple Dog Entries

Stud Dog: for Stud Dogs and two of their Get. Stud Dog must be entered in the Stud Dog Class and must be shown in the ring with their Get. Get only to be judged, based on the merits of the Get. Get must be entered in a Regular Class, Best of Breed or some Non-Regular Class other than Stud Dog Class.

Brood Bitch: substitute Brood Bitch for Stud Dog and Produce for Get. As the Judges decision in the Stud Dog & Brood Bitch classes will be based on the merits of more than one dog or bitch, no one of the dogs or bitches making up the entry judged First in the class will be eligible to compete for Best of Breed by virtue of having won this class.

Parade of Titleholders: The Parade of Titleholders is open to any Weimaraner holding any AKC or WCA title. Each entrant will receive a rosette with its name imprinted on it and will be listed in the 'Parade' section of the show catalog along with breeders, owners, sire, dam, and BRIEF description of accomplishments.

OPEN JUNIOR CLASS: For Boys and Girls who are at least 10 years and under 14 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have won three First Places, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

OPEN SENIOR CLASS: For Boys and Girls who are at least 14 years and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have won three First Places, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.
